



MUSIC LESSON CONTRACT 2010-2011

Year 1 and 2 Strings Programmes

This contract is to be filled in and signed by a parent or guardian of the pupil, and returned to the **Director of Music** by **Monday August 23rd 2010**. Once your child has been assigned a teacher, you will receive a copy of the contract countersigned by the instrumental teacher, along with your first invoice. The terms set out in this contract are binding for the **entire academic year**, ending in July 2011. Please read the contract terms carefully.

Should parents should wish lessons to cease, written notification must reach the Director of Music no later than a half-term in advance of the required stopping date. Parents will otherwise be requested to pay half a term's fees in lieu of notice. However, we strongly encourage all music students to continue lessons for at least a year so that the rewards of real progress can be experienced and appreciated.
